

Community Council Meeting Notes  
January 8, 2019

- November Community Council notes were reviewed and a motion passed approving the notes.
- Review and Approval of Agenda motion passed approving the agenda
  
- School Improvement Plan: we looked at the funding costs and timelines.
- SIP: Preliminary discussion; review current SIP, data, needs and thoughts for next year. School Report Cards: Grant Elementary has 64% in Language Arts 63% in Math, 59% in Science. Our growth numbers were high in all three areas. Grant Elementary has an A grade.
- Budget Report Mindy reported on budgets - what has been spent and potential spendings in the future including future trainings, and technology.
- Safety: Preliminary discussion of Grant's Reunification Plan: Rock Boyer District Support Services Director came and explained what we need to expect for our reunification plan. There will be a parent check in. The person picking up students must be on the emergency contact card as a contact person. They also must show ID before they can take a student away with them. Parents need a couple of notifications (notes, emails) prior to the reunification drill. Possible locations were discussed: the church on 6300 South and 700 West, the Murray Fire Station on 5900 South, and Willow Pond Park. We agreed to use the church as our first site for a reunification drill.
- Updates: Kindergarten has an aid in the morning and an aid for the afternoon. 19-20 Calendar was released and approved by the board in December. It is posted on the District Website, Digital Technology things to think about for next year. Digital training, Netsmartz, parent night for digital citizenship. We have met all digital citizenship requirements for Community Council for this year.
